

## Who is it for?

This course, set in the context of small groups, is for anyone seeking to become more whole personally and relationally. You might be aware of a need for God's healing and freedom, feel 'stuck' in an area of your life, or be facing challenges or issues that never seem to go away. If so, then this is aimed to be of help to you.

## What is the course about?

Over 7 Wednesday evenings and one Saturday, the material deals with the pursuit of personal wholeness in the context of an intimate relationship with the God who saves, heals and restores us in the area of relationships.

The material explores the brokenness that we can experience, as a result of the way we were brought up. We look at the values and ways of thinking & behaving which shape us, as well as our relationships with our parents/primary caregivers. The present day effects of these relationships, is a primary focus of the material.

Participants will receive a copy of the "In the Beginning" manual, and are encouraged to engage with the material. Participants will also need two supporters who can provide on-going prayer/support for them for the duration of the course.

## What happens on the evening?

Each evening consists of a time of worship, some teaching and then small group time (in safe, confidential, single-sex groups) where participants are encouraged to share and to receive in-depth prayer ministry.

## Teaching areas include:

- ✝ In the beginning: God's original plan for us & our own beginnings
- ✝ The Cross.
- ✝ God's original intention for our relationship with our Mother.
- ✝ God's original intention for our relationship with our Father.
- ✝ Our relationships with our siblings and peer group
- ✝ The Healing Process and moving forward.

## What will it cost?

There is a cost of £30 per person to cover materials & administration costs. Please make cheques payable to Riverside Vineyard Church. Financial assistance is available should the course cost be an issue; please speak to Bethan Chapman at the church office.

## When and where?

The course will begin on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2014, at 7.45pm at the Vineyard Centre, Feltham. It runs for 7 Wednesday evenings until 21<sup>st</sup> May, with a break for Easter – 16<sup>th</sup> April as well as 14<sup>th</sup> May.
