Daniel 5: 1-6 (NIVUK)

¹ King Belshazzar gave a great banquet for a thousand of his nobles and drank wine with them. ² While Belshazzar was drinking his wine, he gave orders to bring in the gold and silver goblets that Nebuchadnezzar his father had taken from the temple in Jerusalem,

⁴ As they drank the wine, they praised the gods of gold and silver, of bronze, iron, wood and stone.


Daniel 5: 1-6 (NIVUK)
